Please be very careful about using photographs you've downloaded from the internet or copied from magazines, newspapers etc. We can, where possible, take a suitable photograph to support your article if you don't own one or can't legitimately acquire one. Please contact our editor editortmj3@gmail.com if your not sure about whether you can use a photograph.

If written material is taken from a previously published source and not written by the contributor, please provide details of the original source of the material.
